My name is Cocky and I lived here many years ago when this was a working farm.

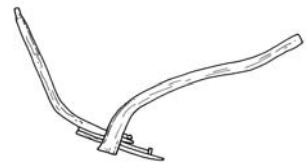
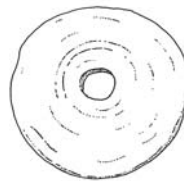


My owner was very rich and his house had beautiful mosaic floors. Draw the one you like the most.

I lived on this farm with many other animals. Can you find these objects that show that people were farming here.

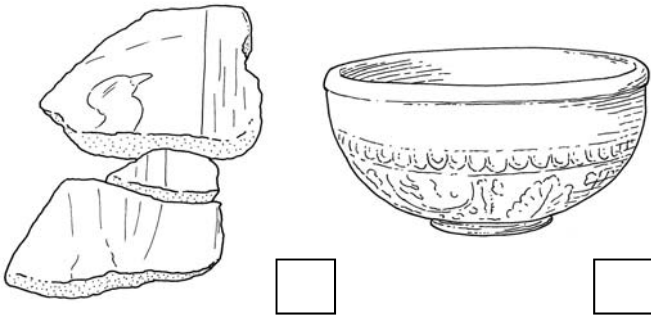


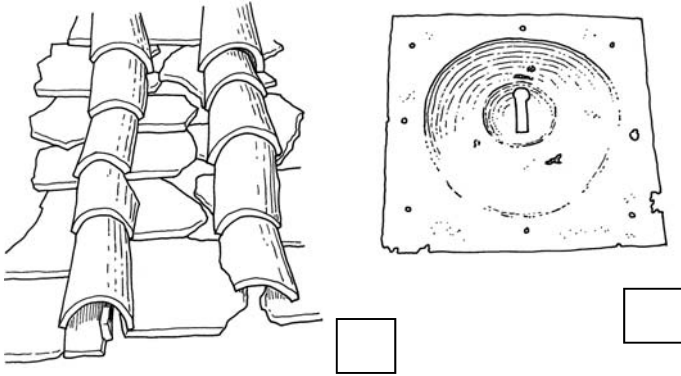

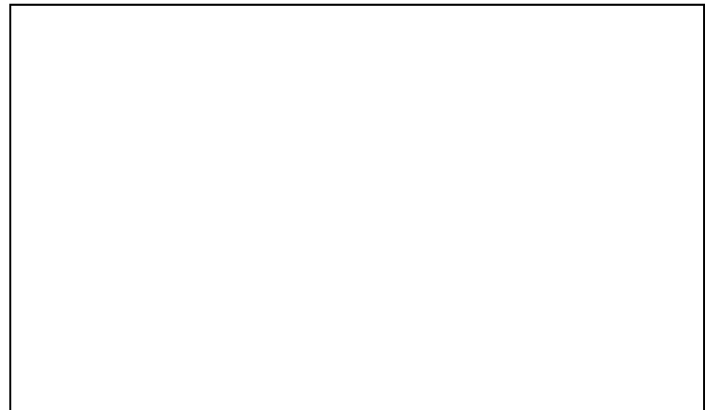


This is my Roman kitchen.

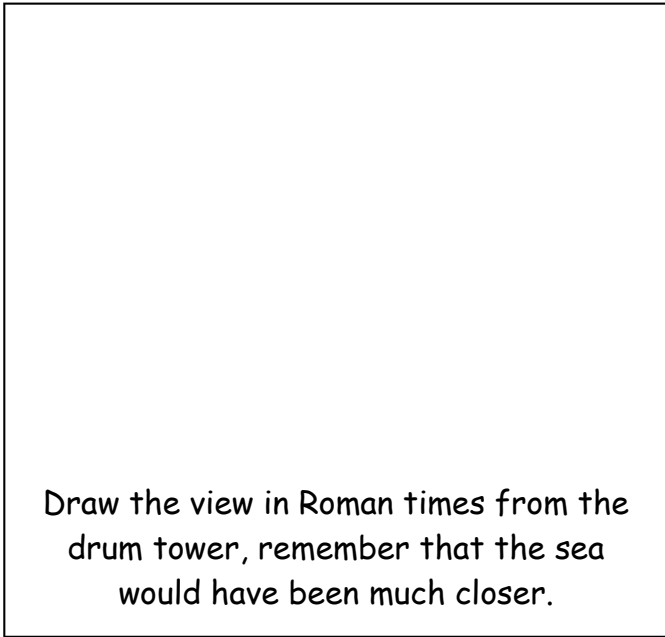


Name 3 differences to your kitchen at home?

This is a picture of how my house used to look before there was a fire here.

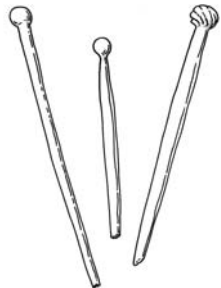
